## INTRODUCTION

**P**laying Blackjack to Win" teaches you all you need to know about playing Blackjack. If you follow my instructions and practice several hours each day you can be a consistent winner. If you are learning just so you can have more fun on your vacations, then I suggest you dust off "Playing Blackjack to Win" and practice a week or so prior to hitting the tables. Vacations will be more fun than ever if you win enough to pay all expenses plus bring a few bucks home. It's nice to take several free vacations each year instead of saving up all year to pay for one vacation.

I had a lot of fun, and, to my surprise, learned things I didn't know about Blackjack when I attended one of the nation's finest Dealers School. If you want to become a professional Blackjack Player, I would strongly suggest that you attend a Dealers School first. Most of them are four hours per day, five days a week for four weeks. You spend the entire time dealing and playing Blackjack. You can spend several hours each day after class working on the techniques and strategies I have outlined for you. By the time you graduate from Dealers school and your own private school taught by "Playing Blackjack To Win," you will be ready to hit the tables as a professional.

The material in Chapters I thru XIX is intended to teach you the rules and techniques for playing winning Blackjack. What I have here are two excellent methods, not systems, because you not only will learn a strict money management and basic game strategy, but Blackjack playing techniques that will increase your winnings in a shorter period of time. The non-cancellation method on pages 13-14 can be used with one, two or four decks. There is no canceling of any cards, and it can be used anywhere in the world with the same success. Start learning this first and then read the cancellation method. It will help you to learn the meaning of face value cards and why you need to make adjustment plays.

Chapters XXI thru XXVII were taken from the Blackjack Dealers Handbook that is used to teach the course. I want to teach you how to play Blackjack correctly along with giving you all the "inside information" about your opponents - the Dealer, Pit Boss and casino - while I teach you how to play winning Blackjack.

You will always be a consistent winner at Blackjack if you treat the game as a business. When I said business, I refer to your dollar investment. If you bet two hundred dollars and win one hundred dollars that is a 50% return on your initial investment- not a bad return for a few minutes of work. My

methods are easy to learn since everything has been included to guide you during your practice session. If you do not practice at home then forget about going to a casino. If you take this game seriously, then winning can be a lot of fun.

Think positive and don't give your money away. The casino Dealers are excellent craftsmen in their trade. They are well paid for their work. Tipping (toke) foolishly can be very costly. You will learn more about this in a later chapter. Remember that the casinos stay in business because of foolish Players, so don't help the casinos build bigger monuments. Therefore, it is most important for you to quit while you are ahead as I state in the bankroll win limits. The feeling of walking away a winner is what my material is all about. Should you find yourself on a "losing streak", which does happen a third of the time, never push those losses. If you do, you're heading for disaster. Patience is the "key" to winning. No one can have an endless winning streak. Should anyone tell you that they could win 100% of the time, ask him if he can also walk on water. There will be periods when you do everything right but the Dealer never loses. Here is when your anger develops and now you're determined to beat that Dealer at any cost - forget it. Just walk away from the table and relax. This cooling off period is a must.

Through the application of the principles of these methods exactly as they are published in these pages and with sincere practice, you will become a Blackjack expert in a short time. I want to stress that practice is a must. All true professionals whether they be actors, musicians, athletes, chess players etc. continuously practice in order to remain in top shape. So must the Blackjack Player. I practice continually just as any professional does.

For the beginner, I recommend that you play with small bets and with two other Players. This way you do not feel self-conscious and can relax. Head on playing (Dealer and yourself) is the best way to play. This can be done after some experience with the game. A good Player is a "silent" Player. Win small amounts and move on to another table or casino. Take rest sessions between playing. Not all casinos have as liberal rules as Las Vegas. It is wise to check the casino's rules in a new area and then adjust your playing accordingly. And one final point, the keys to success are: the knowledge of this game, practice, patience and knowing when to quit...

## IV

### BASIC BLACKJACK RULES FOR WINNING

The First Concern of a Player who wants to master the game of Blackjack is to have a thorough understanding of the game and rules. Again I have stressed the fact that Blackjack rules may vary in different casinos so it is best to consult the Dealer regarding any house rules for Blackjack. We have found that the variations are slight enough that the "Basic Game Strategy" is not affected. Almost all playing strategy depends on the Dealer's up card.

**Option Plays:** Doubling down, splitting pairs, insurance and surrender are called option plays. Surrender is offered in some casinos. This option play can be valuable if you cancel cards. A Player may surrender his hand (first two cards dealt) and pay the Dealer half of his original bet.

**The Psychological Battleground:** Yes, it's quite true that the moment you enter into any gaming casino you have started combat. Between the Dealers, Pit Bosses and the tourists who love to lose their money, you certainly have your work cut out. But have no fears, you can beat them...

If you want to win at this game, you must take it seriously. Treat Blackjack as a business and protect your investment at all cost...

Before you attempt to use my systems at the casino tables, it is extremely important that you play with the smallest units allowed. Once you have established a rhythm in your playing and feel relaxed, which you **can** do, then play for real winnings. You must feel comfortable when playing, otherwise stay out of the casino. If you have any doubts or fears about your playing ability, then keep practicing at home.

Money management is a must, so give yourself a win goal.

You can't expect to win hundreds of dollars with a \$1 unit-bet. That's not a realistic figure. However, for the \$1 unit-bet, winning \$50-\$100 is much more realistic. Let's suppose you are starting with a \$5 unit-bet, which would require at least a \$175 bankroll – 35 times your \$5 unit bet. That is not a large bankroll when you consider that there may be plays in which you have as much as \$100 riding on the hand. How is such a large wager possible? It's easy, if your plus count is high and you could have a 5 unit-bet (5 units at \$5 per unit equals \$25) you split a pair (another \$25) and the next card has the option for doubling down (another \$25) and the other half of the split pair has the very same option. The sum of the total on the original \$25 bet has grown to \$100. Multiple bets on one hand is something that will happen quite often.

There is no absolute formula that guarantees that you will win the moment that you place your first bet. If you should lose a few bucks from the onset of playing, don't let it bug you. If you start getting flustered, then the best solution is to quit playing. Here again is where patience is an asset. Try it, it does work.

No matter what your bankroll is, give yourself a winning goal. In other words, if you start with a \$100 bankroll and win \$50, that's a pretty good win. You must be realistic about the sum, so a 50% win is a good indication as to quitting time. However, if your winning streak is riding high, stay with it until you have lost four hands in a row. Then, quit for a while – a guaranteed winner. The object is to never turn a winning streak into a losing streak. This is an excellent and very profitable rule. Relax, and then go back for another session. Blackjack can be a very tiring game, so don't grind the tables.





## XIX

### MY "CARDINAL RULES" FOR PLAYING BLACKJACK

**Rule One:** How much money to play with. That will depend upon your finances. The small bettor or large wager wins proportionally. The amount of your bankroll, in reference to how much you intend to bet, is very important to take advantage of the various bets you should make. To simplify your betting, we will use the term "units" in reference to money. How much money will you need to play the game? That will depend upon your own finances. Never lose more than you can afford. A safe amount to start a game, your bankroll, should be equal to thirty-five times your unit bet to cover all options of betting that may occur. Example: Your unit bet is  $\$5 \times 35 = \$175$  bankroll needed.

**Rule Two:** Best time to play: When the casino is least crowded. Mornings, just before the tourists go to breakfast or during show time are good. The late night playing is passé. First of all, it's too fatiguing and Pit Bosses put everyone on one table. Have some rest prior to playing. Don't overlook physical fatigue. You must be alert at all times. The worst time to play is when people leave the shows. They crowd the table, and that's the time for you to relax. Did you know that more money is lost just prior to or just after show times? No one seems to care how he or she plays. They are just killing time and you cannot win under those circumstances. Only play when you have perfect playing conditions. The fewer distractions, the better your chances of winning consistently are.

**Rule Three:** Seating Positions: Where you sit at the table is also very important. Centerfield (opposite the Dealer) gives you the advantage of seeing all the cards on the right and left side of you. Right field or third base, as it is sometimes called, is the last seat to the right of the Dealer. Here again you can see all the cards played and you make the final decision as to the Dealer's hand. This is my favorite position. If no advantage seat is available, don't sit down just to kill time, look elsewhere. Remember; give yourself all the advantages for winning.

#### Other Hints in General

1. Do not play if you don't like the Dealer.
2. Never play when you have disturbing thoughts on your mind. If you play cool, calm and accurate, it will be almost impossible for you to lose.
3. Don't play if there are bad Players at your table. More money is lost foolishly by these Players and can ruin your game.
4. If any personality conflict arises with the Dealer or other Players, leave the table immediately. There are lots of other tables.
5. Tipping the Dealer is important. I tip a Dealer, based on how they run the game and their attitude, like I do a

waitress/waiter serving me. The time to tip is when you are leaving the table or when the Dealer is leaving. That Dealer may not return to that table or you may leave before they return. Tipping the same amount in the form of bets for the Dealer is not remembered during the middle of a fast moving game, as much as a personal tip given to them. Also, if you loose a hand that you bet on for the Dealer, the casino gets it - not the Dealer. You will probably spend less and be remembered more this way.

6. Never guess; play exactly as the Basic Game Strategy, Money Management, and your count dictates.
7. Always keep your count accurate; it's to your advantage.
8. Always bet your money in accordance with your units. Don't be afraid to make a good substantial bet if you know the count is in your favor (I am not contradicting my policy on unit betting). There will be many excellent occasions where you should take full advantage of this situation. But make sure that you leave the table after you collect your bet. The Dealer will be very suspicious of your playing ability.
9. Practice is a must. Just before you start playing, seriously go over the count, the playing strategy and the betting rules.

If you want success, you must work at it. A good positive attitude is the stepping-stone to success at the Blackjack tables. I must also stress that patience is one quality you must have in order to use the method successfully. If you cannot wait patiently for the favorable situations to appear, you cannot win money using this method or any other method. I hope you will follow all my suggestions and playing strategies faithfully. This book was written in simple to understand language, and includes everything you need to know about winning Blackjack consistently.

#### A Quick and Simple Proof that My Method Does Work

Will my method work for you??? You bet it will. The best proof you'll have is when your initial investment has multiplied \$\$\$\$\$. Here is a simple way to prove to yourself that you can win with my method. Try this easy experiment in your home and practice Blackjack with your friends, making sure that you use all the casino rules. (Hit sixteen and stand on seventeen) Depending on how many decks you are going to use, simply remove two of each of the non-tens from one, two or four decks. Their removal makes the deck consistently ten-rich. When you begin to play with this "cut-down" deck, even though the composition of the cards will change, the deck will usually be favorable, so you can keep your bets constant. If you use two coins as a bet, it will make the payoffs on natural and taking of insurance easy. Also, use the playing strategy that you would use when



making your maximum bet. After a short time, you should be completely confident that my method works and you should never have any doubts.

Study Chapter XVI, Option Plays, last, because this requires full command of the Basic Game Strategy, Money Manage-

ment and Single Point Count. If you are a sincere Blackjack Player and really want to win large sums of money, I can only stress that you practice the game in the confines of your home regularly, especially a few hours of practice prior to visiting the casino.
